Code Questions and Concerns:

1. The Rules Review Commission acted on requests for Legislative review of N.E.C. 210.12(b) Arc-Fault Circuit-Interrupter Protection for Dwelling Units: All 125 volt, single phase 15- and 20 ampere branch circuits supplying outlets installed in dwelling unit family rooms, dining rooms, living rooms, parlors, libraries, dens, bedrooms, sunrooms, recreation rooms, closets, hallways, or similar rooms or areas shall be protected by a listed arc-fault circuit interrupter, combination-type, installed to provide protection of the branch circuit.
Approved by the commission this article will become effective January 1, 2009.
2. The Rules Review Commission acted on requests for Legislative review of N.E.C. 338.10(b) 4(a) Installation Methods for Branch Circuits and Feeders:
(a) Interior Installations. In addition to the provisions of this article, Type SE service-entrance cable used for interior wiring shall comply with the installation requirements of Part II of Article 334
Approved by the commission this article will become effective immediately.
3. The Rules Review Commission has not made a decision on the requests for Legislative Review of N.E.C. 406.11 Tamper-Resistant Receptacles in Dwellings.
