Code Questions and Concerns:

1. The Rules Review Commission received 10-written requests for Legislative review of N.E.C. 210.12(b) Arc-Fault Circuit-Interrupter Protection for Dwelling Units: All 125 volt, single phase 15- and 20 ampere branch circuits supplying outlets installed in dwelling unit family rooms, dining rooms, living rooms, parlors, libraries, dens, bedrooms, sunrooms, recreation rooms, closets, hallways, or similar rooms or areas shall be protected by a listed arc-fault circuit interrupter, combination-type, installed to provide protection of the branch circuit.

***Unless disapproved by the commission, this article will become effective January 1, 2009.***
