The question comes up a lot about permits that have not been completed by the permit holder for what ever reason.

Section 204.3 Permits is in the NC Administration Code. Please review at your leisure.

Permits that are purchased from our department are your responsibility and you need to manage them. If you have any open permits please feel free to contact us and let us try to help you clear them up.

REMEMBER, permits are public record and everyone can see them.

Permits are good for 6 months after they are issued and 12 month after they have an inspection.

Our department sends out a 5 month letter for permits that are going to expire and also a 11 month letter. This gives you 30 days to work on your inspections.

Trust me when I tell you we do not wish to send any of these violations to the State Board, but soon I will have no choice. So please take care of any old permits and again if you need any help please contact us and let us try to help you.

Reminder, when purchasing permits remember to list all gas outlets, when installing a furnace you will still need to include that gas outlet with any additional outlets.

As of March 10, 2008 we have changed some positions. Darren Young has been promoted to the Commercial Plans Examiner. Troy Allgood will now be inspecting in Darren's old area.
