

**The Earnest Morris Junior Golf Academy
2009 Information Sheet**

The program is designed to introduce, improve and develop the golf skills of children from 8 to 18 years of age. Any 6 year old in the 2008 program will be allowed to participate in the 2009 program at the age of 7. Participants will be taught the rules and etiquette of golf. Instruction will also be given about character development, success and life.

None of the activities or events offered by the program is mandatory. All involvement is left entirely to the discretion of each individual participant. All participants are expected to display proper behavior at all times while attending the program.

The Earnest Morris Junior Golf Academy is sponsored through donations. Attendance in the program includes:

1. No charge for green fees.
2. Professional group instruction based on skill and ability. We separate attendees in to groups named Par, Birdie and Eagle.
3. Instruction on the rules and etiquette of golf.
4. Instruction on character development, success and life.
5. Competitions based on skill, ability and age levels.
6. Each camp attendee will receive a golf shirt and a participation trophy.
7. "Experienced" golf balls are provided at no charge.

Participant Check-In Policy:

All participants must check in at the golf clubhouse porch area. An adult staff member will be with all participants throughout their time at the golf course.

Additional Information:

- All participants must be brought to the golf clubhouse porch area by 9AM, and picked up at the porch area by 12 Noon.
- Participants can bring their lunch daily to the program. Our concession stand is open daily in the clubhouse.
