

ASSISTANT TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR/SIGNALS - 260

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs difficult technical and supervisory work pertaining to the construction, installation, maintenance and repair of electrical and electronic traffic control signals and related devices; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Plans and makes crew assignments for the construction, installation, maintenance and repair of traffic control signals and related equipment; supervises and reviews work of crews in the maintenance and repair of a variety of traffic signals; assists and instructs employees in the proper installation, operation and maintenance of traffic signals and solid state controllers; overhauls traffic signal controllers and cabinets; installs conduits, detectors, poles, pedestals, guy wires, etc.; answers trouble calls for field repairs; may be assigned to night standby duty for emergency repairs; keeps records and makes reports.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to a high school diploma and considerable journeyman experience in specialized electrical and electronic signal and signal control work.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Considerable experience of the installation, operation and maintenance of traffic signals and of electronic and electro-mechanical traffic signal controllers and allied equipment; knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions of the trade; ability to instruct other employees in the operation, maintenance and repair of traffic control devices and allied electrical equipment; ability to interpret blueprints and to apply this knowledge to the operation and repair of traffic control equipment; ability to establish and maintain effective working relations.
