Main Street, Winston-Salem, NC in Room 16 until **2:00 PM, January 10, 2018**, when all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities and to reject any or all proposals. Contractors must be properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the N.C. General Statutes.

Project Description: This project will construct a new 3.9 acre park on vacant property just southeast of the intersection of Bethabara Road and Shattalon Drive. The amenities include a playground, picnic shelter, sprayground, restroom building, dog park, parking lot, concrete sidewalks, walking path, and fenced boundaries.
