RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
WASHINGTON PARK STREAM RESTORATION
CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM, NC

North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) 143-132(a) requires a minimum of three competitive bids be received for formal construction and repair contracts. Should fewer than the required three bids be offered as required by N.C.G.S. 143-129, the project may be re-advertised.

Therefore, pursuant to N.C.G.S. formal bidding laws, sealed proposals endorsed “**Washington Park Stream Restoration Project, FB19161**” will be received by City/County Purchasing, City Hall Building, 101 North Main Street, Winston-Salem, North Carolina in Room 16 until **2:00 pm, February 7, 2019**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Three bids are not required at this second offering; as few as one valid bid may be opened and considered for award per NCGS 143-132.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. Contractors must show evidence that they are properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. Compliance with the City of Winston-Salem’s M/WBE program is required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the specifications.
