➤ Winston-Salem Portrait Project

- The artists chose Aaron Gibbons as the project's fabricator.

➤ Fairgrounds Farmers' Market Murals

➤ Kernersville Library

- 31 artists applied for the artistic bike rack project. 82 artists applied for the courtyard sculpture project. Courtyard sculpture finalists are Harry McDaniel, Erik Beerbower, and Madeline Wiener. Bike Rack finalists are Mike Burke, Bill Coleman, and Suzy Hendrix. David Finn suggested considering a maintenance budget for future repairs to these projects.

➤ Merschel Park

- Finalist interviews are scheduled for September 17.

➤ Fourth Street

- The Commission discussed scheduling the first project committee meeting in December.

➤ Memory Wall of Peace and Love

- The Commission agreed to invite David Brown, Tom Patterson, a Transit Commission member, a transit user, and someone from SECCA to participate in the committee.
