Crime Review figures are preliminary. All crimes are reported based on categories and definitions conforming to Incident Based Reporting (IBR) standards. Murder, Rape, and Agg. Assault are a count of victims; MV Theft is a count of vehicles. All other crimes are a count of incident charges. Part two crimes are other crimes such as city ordinance violations, disorderly conduct, drug charges, trespassing, vandalism, weapon violations, etc. Many of these offenses are a result officers' proactive activity and investigations. For this report, the category of Murder also includes Justifiable Homicides.
