Rules

- Drawings may be in any 2-dimensional medium (pencil, oil, watercolor, marker, colored pencil, crayon, etc.)
- The drawing must represent the 2019 Drinking Water Week theme, "Protect the Source"
- Artwork must be labeled on the back with:
 - Student first and last name
 - Age
 - Grade
 - School
 - Hometown
 - Parent or guardian telephone number and email address

Artwork submitted without *all* of this information will be disqualified.

- Only one drawing per student can be submitted
