Eligibility Requirements

Must Be:

- 16-24 years old on enrollment date
- High School Dropout not possessing a GED

Additional Requirements (must meet at least one):

- A current or former foster youth
- Individual with a disability
- Child of an incarcerated parent
- A youth or adult offender
- Migrant farm worker youth
- Low-Income

5 Main Components of YouthBuild Winston-Salem

- **Education**
 - Participants will work toward High School Diploma/GED attainment
- **Construction**
 - Participants will gain practical job skills training
- **Leadership Development**
 - Participants will enhance their decision making skills and focus on personal accountability
- **Individualized Case Management**
 - Participants will receive support in developing and executing action plans to meet their desired life goals
- **Graduate Resources**
 - Participants will receive continued academic, occupational, and/or developmental support after they have graduated from the program
