### **Expectations of Vendors**

1. The market will abide by up-to-date CDC, state and city protocols for safety regarding COVID-19 at all times. Vendors and consumers are expected to follow these guidelines.
  - a. This includes current protocols for physical and social distancing, wearing a facial covering at all times, and self-quarantining if you have been exposed to COVID-19 or are showing symptoms
  - b. Market will provide to all vendors:
    - i. Facial coverings (disposable masks) at each market for all vendors
    - ii. Hand sanitizer & disinfectant
    - iii. Disposable gloves
    - iv. Physical and social distancing markings at the market (one-way aisles, spacing between vendors)
    - v. Electric outlet at each vending space
    - vi. Coordination of SNAP/EBT (4% transaction fee)

2. Vendors are responsible for
  - a. Bringing their own table/vending booth. Each vending space will be under one of the two pavilions, therefore covered and with an electric outlet.
  - b. Safety protocols for shopping, including limiting sampling, customer touching, physical interaction at unsafe distances with customers
  - c. Payment acceptance methods at the vendors preference for electronic payments (with the exception of SNAP/EBT coordinated by the market) and/or cash
  - d. Arrive by 3:30 pm to set up and be ready to open by 4 pm
  
3. Information about shopping
  - a. The market shall provide free facial coverings for all customers and require they are properly worn at the market
  - b. The market shall provide hand sanitizer and request that customers apply sanitizer when entering the market
  - c. Vendors are not expected to enforce these requirements or preferences
  - d. Restrooms and drinking water are not available for customers
