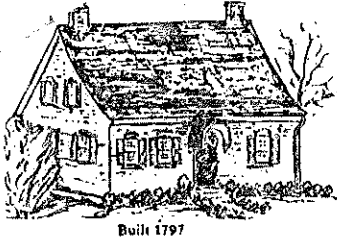

A path from Main Street to the Graveyard was laid out in 1839.

Lot # 43 is most probably the lot which is now 327 S. Main Street.

A two-story shop was built on this lot in 1840 by Theophilus Vierling.

In 1849 the house belonged to the widow, Mary Hine. In 1853 Orren Mitchell bought the house of his mother-in-law, the widow Mary Hine. In 1854 Eugene Hartwig bought the house of Orren Mitchell. In 1855 Eugene Hartwig sold the upper part of his lot, including the house hitherto occupied by Aquilla Jones, to Alan Welfare. In 1860 Welfare (Wohlfahrt) took a deed to the north half of lot No. 43. In 1913 the Welfare house was occupied by W. P. Ormsby. In 1857 the south half of lot Nol 43 was deeded to James Hall. In 1913 it belonged to Charles B. Pfohl.

In Volume XI Records of the Moravians you will find information on Welfare and when the deed was made to him in the description of the aboration of the lease system in Salem.

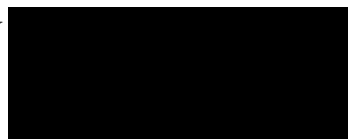
This is what we could find re the Ormsby House. I hope it will be helpful. You might check the Court House for later deeds.
