TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This curbside exemption application is for garbage only!

- You must provide your own personal garbage can(s). The 96-gallon city-issued cart may NOT be used for this service.
- You are allowed up to two (2) 45-gallon cans or three (3) 33-gallon cans.
- Your trash can(s) must be easily accessible and not enclosed in a fence, garage or locked compartment.
- Service may not be available during inclement weather.
- There must be no one in the home capable of bringing can(s) to the curb.
- You must provide a letter from your medical provider verifying that neither you nor anyone in your house is capable of rolling a garbage cart to the curb.
- The letter must be dated and printed on the medical practice letterhead.
- Your application will not be processed until we receive BOTH this application and your medical verification letter. Please send both in one envelope.
- You must reapply for an exemption with a new medical verification letter every three (3) years.
- If you do not reapply you will be removed from the exemption list.

To receive a curbside garbage collection exemption:

1. Get a letter from your medical provider verifying that neither you, nor anyone living at your address, is physically able to roll the garbage cart out to the curb. **THIS LETTER MUST BE DATED AND ON THE LETTER-HEAD OF THE MEDICAL PRACTICE.** Keep a copy for your records.

2. Print and fill out this application form and mail it with your medical provider's note to:

Be sure to sign and date the application. Applications that are not signed and dated will not be processed.

3. Allow at least two weeks for your exemption application to be processed. If your application is approved you will receive a copy stamped with the date that your exemption will expire.
