

Foot Peddler Permit Questions Answered

Question: How do I submit a permit application?

Answer: Permits may be submitted in person at the Office of Business Inclusion and Advancement located at 101 N. Main Street, Suite 232, Winston-Salem NC 27101.

Question: What are the prohibited hours for peddling in a residential zoning district?

Answer: It shall be unlawful to peddle on foot or from a vehicle between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. in residential zoning district; provided, however that during such periods that daylight savings time is in effect, these hours shall be between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.

Question: Will I be allowed to sale products door to door?

Answer: No. If you wish to sale products door to door you will need to obtain a Permit from the City of Winston-Salem Revenue Department.

Question: Where can I view and or obtain a copy of the City Code regarding my Permit?

Answer: The City Code is available online www.cityofws.org/footpeddlers to view/print.

Question: I have another version of the permit application. Can I continue to use the older version of the permit application form?

Answer: No. In order to streamline the submission/review process, the only acceptable permit application is the version attached.
