

THE FOLLOWING CONCERNS HOUSEHOLD GENERATED WASTE ONLY AND DOES NOT INCLUDE COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL OR INSTITUTIONALLY GENERATED WASTE

No disposal of commercial quantities unless a Special Waste Application is approved. If a major storm occurs citizens can take debris to any landfill except Old Salisbury Road, as long as they indicate that it is storm clean up.

WE ARE RESTRICTED BY STATE PERMIT TO ONLY ACCEPT WASTE FROM ONLY CERTAIN COUNTIES:
HANES MILL ROAD LANDFILL: FORSYTH, STOKES, SURRY, DAVIE, AND YADKIN

This Landfill also has a recycling station and will accept construction and demolition waste.
The following items are accepted:

- Bloody mattress IF THE BLOOD HAS DRIED. No free liquids of any type are allowed.
- Hypodermic needles PROVIDED THEY ARE EMPTY, AND ARE CONTAINED IN A SHARP PROOF CONTAINER. (These answers apply to individuals bringing these items; there are specific rules in place for medical waste generated from doctor's offices and hospitals. Questions from these facilities create an Utilities Solid Waste - Waste Acceptance Requests SR)
- Mufflers or radiators
- Lawnmowers
- Barbeque grills
- Propane tanks (full or empty)
- Land clearing debris, NOT YARDWASTE
- Construction and demolition debris
- Demolished mobile homes - we do NOT demolish mobile homes at our landfills; Caller does NOT need to notify landfill prior to disposal

OLD SALISBURY ROAD LANDFILL: FORSYTH ONLY
(Construction and demolition waste)

- Land clearing debris, NOT YARDWASTE
- Demolished mobile homes - we do NOT demolish mobile homes at our landfills. Caller does NOT need to notify landfill prior to disposal

OVERDALE YARDWASTE: NO RESTRICTIONS
FORUM 52 YARDWASTE: NO RESTRICTIONS
(Yard waste only)

3RC

- Used oil filters will be recycled
- Gasoline
- Fertilizer

What kind of waste do you have?

- If household garbage/waste, you can take it to the Hanes Landfill only.
- All Wooden Pallets will ONLY go to either of the Yard Waste Facilities, Overdale or Forum 52
- All Plastic Bottles are to be placed in the Recycling Bin or taken to one of the Recycling Centers

- Oil Tanks - Must be cut in half and clean out as much as possible. Holes should be poked in the tanks also. (If the caller takes these to Atlantic Scrap they will be reimbursed for the item)
- Railroad Ties

If waste is coming from the process of demolishing, renovating, or constructing something AND does not contain liquids, you may take it to the Old Salisbury Road Landfill or you may also take it to Hanes Landfill.

Do you have yard waste?

If the waste is yard waste - tree/bush trimmings, grass clippings, etc.- then you must take it to one of the yard waste facilities.

All yard waste debris including:

- grass clippings
- leaves
- tree limbs
- brush of any size will be accepted
- root balls

If generated from the process of maintaining a yard (yard waste), then the root ball goes to Overdale or Forum 52, provided the other contaminants (dirt, rocks) are incidental to the load. If the contaminants are NOT incidental to the load, then the load will be rejected. The customer will then be told that the root ball can go to Overdale or Forum 52 but the other contaminants can go to Hanes Landfill.

Yard waste mixed with other materials such as garbage, junk or household trash must be separated and household waste must be taken to Hanes Landfill.

Do you have any waste tires?

As a resident of Winston-Salem you can take up to 5 tires annually to the Hanes landfill at no charge, but they must be off the wheel/rims. All tires over 5 will be charged a fee. Monday - Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3 p.m. are the only times that tires can be disposed at the landfill. Tires cannot be disposed of on Saturdays and Holidays. Any additional tires (over the amount of 5) will be charged a tire disposal fee of \$80.90 per ton.

Do you have any white goods?

White goods are defined as; stoves, ranges, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioning units, hot water heaters, dish washing machines, clothes washing machines, clothes dryers, fireplace inserts, floor model gas, oil, or wood fired heaters, trash compactors, and large humidifiers/dehumidifiers. If you have any of these white goods you may take them to the Hanes Landfill free of charge. Examples of items NOT classified as white goods: microwave ovens, small tabletop appliances, toaster ovens, bread baking machines, food processors, food mixers, food blenders, garbage disposals, gas/charcoal grills, vacuum cleaners, TVs, copiers, stereo equipment, propane gas tanks, and electric fans.

Do you have any TVs, computers, stereos, etc.?

Year-round, residents may drop off these televisions and computer equipment at no charge at any attended Goodwill Donation Center and at 3RC The Enviro-Station at 1401 S. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, across from Bowman Gray Stadium.

Businesses should make arrangements for disposing of their e-waste through 3RC, the company that operates the Enviro-Station, or through Goodwill Industries of Northwest North Carolina, which can schedule a pick-up of commercial donations. Does your waste contain asbestos?
